

CADAR RIDE. SEEK. FIND.

The idea of this Ride, Seek, Find (R.S.F.) is to encourage riders to get out and explore this great land of ours, have some fun and a purpose all at the same time, whilst riding in a safe way. The good thing about this R.S.F. is that it can be done individually or with others and you can choose when to do it. Entry forms will be available from the February meeting at Hilton. There is no time limit as such, provided it is completed no later than 11th November 2012, when all entries must be in. Any received after that date will not be entered into the competition.

The format is very simple - you will have a group of 8 images of SIGN POSTS, which will be near a place of interest, ie: an Ancient Monument, Museum, Historical House and so on. You will then work out where the sign post is by use of maps ?, I suggest you use minor roads where possible to enhance the ride. You will then ride to the sign post without the aid of a sat nav (taken on trust). And there discover the place of interest which will be within a mile or so of the sign post. You will then go to the place of interest and photograph your motorcycle by the entrance or object depending on the site. I do not expect you to pay to go into the place of interest unless you wish to do so.

**PLEASE DO NOT CAUSE AN OBSTRUCTION OR A SAFETY HAZARD
AND BE MINDFUL OF TRAFFIC WHILE TAKING PHOTOS**

You must submit a photo of each place of interest, which must also show your motorcycle in the picture. At the end of October the R.S.F. will end, you will then submit all photos with your name, to me at the November meeting at Hilton or by e-mail at davesmx5@btinternet.com. Please do not send before 1st November but no later than 11th November. The person with the most correct entries will win, in the event of a tie there will be tie breaker photo and the first to send it in will be the winner. My judgement will be final. Entries without your bike in the picture will not be counted. I am happy to accept photos on plain paper, there is no need to waste photographic paper on entries. There will be a prize for the winner.

As this is the first one, I have made it reasonably easy, with the place of interest actually on the signpost, with a small map. The theme for the first one is TRANSPORT. In future years they will be a little harder to detect, with no map and maybe no theme.
